Day Camp 2016

Ahoy there matey's! Welcome to Little Peoples Landing Day Camp Program! We are very excited to have your child (ren) with us for the summer.

Our day camp program is for children ages 5 to 12 years of age. Our camp runs during the summer months while the kids are off from school, and is intended to provide your day camper with a variety of safe, stimulating, and fun activities to make sure this is a memorable summer for everyone! We operate our summer day camp program during the traditional summer vacation for the Boulder Valley school district.

At the beginning of the summer there is a \$15.00 registration fee for current LPL families.

This registration fee covers the cost of the water bottle and t-shirt that the kids wear throughout the summer. If you are not a currently enrolled LPL family, we do have an additional \$100 registration fee that entitles you to two-weeks of vacation based on how many days a week you are enrolled over the summer. If you choose not to pay the \$100 registration fee for the summer, you will not be able to use vacation time during the summer. If you choose to stay enrolled with us in the Fall, you can pay that \$100 registration fee at that time.

Additionally, in order to help with the cost of gas, there will be a \$30 fuel charge which can be paid up front at the beginning of the summer. We feel that it is a more preferable alternative than to restrict the number of field trips offered and the distance of our field trips.

If you sign up for less than 5 days a week, it is important that your child attends LPL on the same days of the week each week. Our reservations at many locations are made for a specific number of children and can be very difficult to change to the number of children actually attending. If for some reason you do need to change the days that your child attends at any time, we ask that you please give us sufficient notice when possible.

While attending the daily field trips, we expect everyone to follow the same LPL rules and all of the rules of the facility we are visiting. For the safety of the other children, and the LPL staff, if someone chooses not to follow the rules, he/she may be removed from the day camp program.

Additionally, the security and safety of our children is our primary concern throughout the summer. Therefore, we must strictly adhere to our policy of the children leaving their field trip shirts at LPL at the end of each day, to allow the shirts to be laundered and not forgotten at home. ALL CHILDREN WHO ATTEND THE FIELD TRIPS MUST WEAR THEIR SHIRTS WHILE THEY ARE OUT OF THE BUILDING. The rule for the day camp shirts will enable our staff to easily recognize the children in their care and ensure adequate safety of the children.

Due to an increase of popularity of electronic devices, such as tablets, we want to encourage the children to make sure that those devices are left safely at home during the week, with the exception of selected Fridays, at which time the children may have structured time to spend on those devices. LPL is NOT responsible for any devices that are lost or stolen during attendance of day camp. DEVICES ARE BROUGHT TO LPL AT YOUR OWN RISK.

The buses will leave LPL each day at the times listed for each specific field trip, a majority of which are morning trips, and require your children to be here no later than 8:00am. Please check your field trip calendar and the day camp schedule that will be posted each week by the check-in computer regarding what time the children will need to be here, any changes in the schedule, and what the children may need to bring for specific field trips. Most field trips will return to LPL no later than 3:00pm each day, with the exception of our larger field trips. Unfortunately, the field trips cannot leave late or return early for any individual children or circumstances.

As part of your tuition, a nutritious lunch as well as AM and PM snacks are provided to the children. If a field trip allows us to stay at LPL for lunch, we will eat what is posted on our school lunch menu for the day. For our big trips (Water World, Elitch Gardens, Rockies games, etc.) we will provide a universal sack lunch for the children that will consist of a sandwich, chips, juice, fruit snacks, fresh fruit, and a cookie. Please see the attached menu for specific lunches.

Please remember that the following field trips do have an additional charge that will be due one week prior to the field trip: Rockies Game, Elitch Gardens, Rafting, and Water World. For questions regarding the prices of these field trips, please see the calendar attached. We are only able to purchase a limited number of tickets for these events, and do require additional permission forms to be signed prior to the trip so that we may know ahead of time who will be attending. You will be able to find these additional permission forms posted by the check-in computer.

During the summer, we will also have various activities planned for the children so that they stay structured, and their minds stay fresh. Before each field trip, the children will engage in a discussion about what it is that they will be doing that day. After the field trips, the children will have an activity based on the field trip for that day. These activities may be science projects, art projects, or even cooking!

We will use our Rocky Mountain SPF 30 sunscreen on the children who do not supply their own sunscreen. Whether or not providing your child's sunscreen, please be sure that it has been applied before they arrive at school for the day, and if providing your child's sunscreen, please be sure that some is provided to our teachers at LPL to reapply throughout the day. We will take all sunscreen on field trips each day for reapplication.

****Note:** Due to the unpredictable Colorado weather, as well as for the safety of the children, we ask that the children do not wear flip-flops except for on pool/water days.

Please make sure to complete all Day Camp paperwork in the registration packet and return it to management by no later than Friday, May 13th so that we can submit final summer counts, and staff appropriately.

We are looking forward to a fun-filled, busy and successful summer with your kiddos! Please feel free to contact us with any questions or concerns that you may have. We are excited to provide you and your child(ren) with a safe place to anchor for the 2016 summer!
