Welcome to Day Camp!! We are very excited to have your child join us for an amazing summer of fun and friends!! This newsletter is to give you and your child a few reminders of what to expect during this busy summer.

Sunscreen

Little People's Landing will provide Rocky Mountain Sunscreen with an SPF of 30. We will apply this to all children, unless otherwise stated by parents, before and during outside activities. If your child has sensitive skin or other special sunscreen needs, you may provide your own bottle.

T-Shirts/Water Bottles

Every child will receive a T-shirt and water bottle. Our shirts are made out of a much better fabric than cotton. They will be cooler and dry easier for the children. We would like all our children to be in the bright, red shirts so they are easily identifiable to the teachers and each other while on field trips. The shirts will remain at Little People's Landing throughout the summer. We will wash them every Friday or more if needed. When shirts go home, they tend to not return the following day and no child may attend a field trip without their shirt. Children will also receive a water bottle, which will remain at LPL. We want to make sure our children stay hydrated during these hot summer months!

Clothing

Please be conscientious of how your child's clothes and shoes relate to our planned activities each day. For example: tennis shoes and socks are necessities for hikes but sandals may be preferable for other field trips. Due to safety issues, we ask that flip flops only be worn on swim days as they easily fall off children's feet which can cause injuries.

Menus

Included in this newsletter are the menus for the summer. We have made every effort to make our lunches healthy, yummy, and varied. We ask that no outside food be brought from home unless there is an allergy restriction to what we will be serving. In that case, please speak with the Director at the start of camp so we can be on the same page. All children and teachers will be eating meals provided by LPL.

No Money

Please remember that we do not allow the children, or teachers, to purchase additional items while they are on field trips. Our reasoning: not every child has the ability to have extra money and in many cases we have problems (some severe) when only some of the

children can get a souvenir. While we understand both sides of the fairness issue, we have determined the best policy is for NO cash to accompany the children to camp.

Items From Home

We ask that all items from home remain at home. We are not responsible for lost, stolen, or broken toys. We are going to have a busy summer with lots of children and we will not be able to keep track of all the "extras" that come into our center. We will, however, allow hand held video games and music players with the following stipulations (please remind your child of these when they bring them):

- 1. They may only be played during <u>teacher-approved</u> times throughout the day. Otherwise, they must stay in cubbies or on the locked bus during field trips.
- 2. All games and music must be <u>appropriate for all children</u>. If we deem something is inappropriate we will confiscate it and send it home with the parents that night.
- 3. It is your child's responsibility to keep track of it. <u>If anything is lost, broken, or stolen, we will not be held responsible</u>. We are simply allowing these to come but strongly encourage them to stay at home.

Cell Phones

Cell Phones are prohibited from being used at LPL for all children and staff (except for school cell phones). We ask that children refrain from bringing their cell phones to Day Camp. If they need to for any reason, they will be kept in the office until they leave. Why? It is very hard to monitor who children are talking to and what kinds of conversations are taking place. Also, most phones now have cameras. There are very strict confidentiality laws out there to protect children and the privacy of their families. Lots of kids like to take pictures of their friends and send them to other friends. Due to confidentiality, we cannot allow this to happen. If you need to contact your child, or they need to reach you, we have phones available at the center as well as LPL cell phones on all field trips. Please call us at the school and we can let you speak with your child at anytime.

LAST WORDS

<u>SEATBELT SAFETY</u>: Please discuss with your child the importance of wearing a seatbelt correctly. Our first priority is their safety and we do strictly enforce the seatbelt laws.

CODE OF CONDUCT: Included in the calendar packets was a copy of our code of conduct. The <u>safety of the children</u> as well as <u>respect for the places we are attending</u> is a huge priority for us. If a child's behavior is disruptive, they will lose out on the next field trip they will be in attendance for. Excessive behavior issues going against this code of conduct will result in removal from our Day Camp program. Please take some time to read through the code of conduct, sign it and return it. These must be returned within the first

week. Please let us know if you have any questions. Our teachers will be constantly reviewing the rules and manners expected on field trips throughout the summer.

<u>LEAVE TIMES</u>: Please note the leave times for each field trip. These are on the calendars as well as on the weekly day camp schedule by the front doors. This is the time we will be pulling out of the parking lot. Please make sure you are here at least 15 minutes prior to this time so your child has a chance to get their shirt and water bottle before departing. We cannot wait for late children.

<u>LOST AND FOUND</u>: Things do get lost and misplaced. Please check the tub by the front door if you are missing anything. Also remember to label everything that comes into the center. Each child will have a cubby to store their belongings in. We also encourage them to bring a backpack or bag with their name on it to keep track of all their things.

<u>PHOTOS</u>: We take lots of pictures during the summer of all our adventures! We love to hang them in the school as well as post them on facebook for all our families to see the fun we have. We never use children's names or any other personal info, just the photos. If you are okay with your child being included, please complete the waiver and return. You may specify that you are ok with them being used in the school and/or on facebook, website, etc.

Remember that your child will get dirty (we're busy), may lose things and probably will be exhausted each day (we have a blast!!). Talk to us with any concerns you may have...we want everyone to have an amazing summer!!

Code of Conduct

Creating and maintaining a safe learning environment for our children is a team effort. We ask for your help as we strive to protect children's rights while keeping the school environment safe and conducive to learning. We hold high expectations for the children's behavior and believe those high standards benefit children, parents and staff.

We encourage parents and/or guardians to review the code of conduct with their children and support its implementation.

 Please sign and return to the school director. If we do not have it signed, we will not be transporting your child.

In the classrooms:

- Children must be respectful of adults and other children
- Children must respect and not cause damage to school property and/or materials
- Children are prohibited from using inappropriate language or gestures
- Habitually disruptive behavior will not be tolerated
- Hats are to be removed when inside the school
- Fighting and threatening actions towards adults and other children will not be permitted
- Removal of or damage to property belonging to the school, staff or other children will not be tolerated
- Weapons and objects deemed unsafe by the center director of any kind may not be brought into the school
- Violence or inappropriate sexual behavior of any kind towards adults or other children will not be tolerated
- Children may not have any medications in their possession at any time
- Bullying of adults or other children will not be tolerated
- Cell phones are not permitted and may not be used by a child in the classroom, on the playground, on the bus or on a field trip

On the bus:

- Children must cooperate with the driver and follow directions
- Children must remain seated and face forward with their feet in front of them
- Children must keep seat belts on at all times
- Children must be respectful to the other passengers

- Screaming or other loud distractions will not be permitted
- Unsafe items of any kind are prohibited on the bus
- Cell phones may not be used on the bus at any time
- Children may not eat or drink while on the bus
- All personal belongings must remain in the children's back packs while on the bus

School Drop off/Pick up

• If your child does not need to be picked up from school you need to call us and let us know by 2:00pm or you will be subject to charge a \$21 flat rate each day you do not call as we are staffing and bussing to that school for your child.

On a field trip:

- Appropriate attire for the activity is required
- Children must respect staff and follow directions the first time they are given
- Children must stay with their assigned group at all times
- Loud or inappropriate language or gestures will not be tolerated
- Children must respect the staff and facility they are visiting
- Children will refrain from conduct which presents a threat to the safety and welfare of the other children and staff
- Children must adhere to all rules and regulations of the venue visited

Student Discipline:

The objective of discipline is to help the child develop a positive attitude toward self-discipline and socially acceptable behavior. All policies regarding discipline shall be designed to achieve this objective.

Suspension or Disenrollment:

The director or other authorized authority may suspend or withdraw a child at anytime it is
deemed their withdrawal is in the best interest of the other children, parents, staff and/or
school.
