Welcome to our Little People's Landing Summer Camp! We are VERY excited to have your child(ren) with us for the summer. We operate our camp during the traditional summer vacation for Jefferson County school district. Our camp is for children ages 5-12 years, and runs from Tuesday, May 29th through Wednesday, August 15th. Our goal for the summer is to provide your child with a variety of safe, stimulating and fun activities to make this their best summer yet!

The security and safety of your child is our preeminent concern. Therefore, ALL DAY CAMPERS MUST WEAR THEIR LPL DAYCAMP T-SHIRT ON ANY FIELD TRIP OF ANY KIND. This policy must be strictly adhered to on all trips, even swimming. This will enable our teachers to better ensure their safety and their security during all fieldtrips.

The van/bus will generally leave LPL at 9:30am and will normally return no later than 4pm each day unless stated otherwise. Unfortunately, the field trips will not leave late or return early because of individual children or circumstances. If there are any trips that anticipate an earlier departure, or a later return, we will post that information for you on the weekly reminders board located at the base of the stairs to Pirates Hideaway. Please make every effort to have your child arrive in time to get ready for the trip.

For all trips, we will use our Rocky Mountain SPF 30 sunscreen unless you provide us with an alternative sunscreen. Please remember though, that if you would like to bring in an alternative sunscreen, it must be handed to an adult so they can label and keep track of the bottle. We will apply sunscreen prior to leaving the center, at lunch while we are out and about, as well as additional times when we are outside for prolonged periods of time such as park days, Rockies Game, Rocket Day, Water World, and all the swimming pools we visit.

COSTS involved

If you are a newly enrolling or returning for summer family, you must pay the yearly \$100 registration fee. You will gain 1 week of vacation time to use for any days missed over the summer. You also have the option of utilizing half tuition if you are going to be out of the center a full week and would like to save your vacation days for another time. Any current enrolled families will simply pay their fee during their annual month as normal.

Due to the costs of gasoline, we charge all our campers a fee of \$30.00. This charge will cover the entire summer program gas costs. We feel that this is a much better alternative than limiting the number of field trips we offer.

The only additional fee is \$15.00 for a red LPL logo T-shirt and an LPL water bottle that will travel with your child on all fieldtrips. At the end of the summer, both the water bottle and T-shirt are your child's to keep.

The following fieldtrips are an additional fee, and are optional to attend:

- Elitches: \$32.00**
- Rockies game: \$17.00**
- Rafting: \$30.00**
- Water World: \$36.00**

There will be sign-up sheets posted on the front counter in the weeks preceding the big trips. We only have a specific amount of tickets available for these trips, so make sure you sign up your child early!

In the event you do not wish to have your child attend one of the additional cost trips, they would remain at the center for an alternate activity.

Tuition prices are as follows:

5 Full Days	\$280.00	\$1190.00

For any families currently on the **CCAP** program, \$15.00 will be billed each week to cover all fieldtrips during the week, with the exception of the optional large fieldtrips. All monthly parent fees as well as the gas fee and water bottle & T-shirt cost will still apply, and require normal payment by the 5th of the month.

As part of your tuition, a nutritious lunch and an AM and PM snack is provided. Since many of our campers are picky eaters, we have tried to tailor a menu that is more to their varied tastes. If they would prefer to pack a lunch from home instead, we will simply add it to our coolers as we load the busses for each trip. The lunch menu will also be posted on the board at the base of the staircase.

Code of Conduct

Creating and maintaining a safe learning environment for our children is a team effort. We ask for your help as we strive to protect children's rights while keeping the school environment safe and conducive to learning. We hold high expectations for the children's behavior and believe those high standards benefit children, parents and staff.

We encourage parents and/or guardians to review the code of conduct with their children and support its implementation.

In the classrooms:

- Children must be respectful of adults and other children
- Children must respect and not cause damage to school property and/or materials
- Children are prohibited from using inappropriate language or gestures
- Habitually disruptive behavior will not be tolerated
- Hats are to be removed when inside the school
- Fighting and threatening actions towards adults and other children will not be permitted
- Removal of or damage to property belonging to the school, staff or other children will not be tolerated
- Weapons and objects deemed unsafe by the center director of any kind may not be brought into the school
- Violence or inappropriate sexual behavior of any kind towards adults or other children will not be tolerated
- Children may not have any medications in their possession at any time. If they require a medication while out of the school, the medication will be carried in a backpack with the lead teacher
- Bullying of adults or other children will not be tolerated
- Cell phones are not permitted on the playground, on the bus, or on a field trip

On the bus:

- Children must cooperate with the driver and follow directions
- Children must remain seated and face forward with their feet in front of them

- Children must keep seat belts on at all times
- Children must be respectful to the other passengers
- Screaming or other loud distractions will not be permitted
- Unsafe items of any kind are prohibited on the bus
- Cell phones may not be used on the bus at any time
- Children may not eat or drink while on the bus
- All personal belongings must remain in the children's back packs while on the bus

On a field trip:

- Appropriate attire for the activity is required
- Children must respect staff and follow directions they are given
- Children must stay with their assigned group at all times
- Loud or inappropriate language or gestures will not be tolerated
- Children must respect the staff and facility they are visiting
- Children will refrain from conduct which presents a threat to the safety and welfare of the other children and staff
- Children must adhere to all rules and regulations of the venue visited

Student Discipline:

The objective of discipline is to help the child develop a positive attitude toward self-discipline and socially acceptable behavior. All policies regarding discipline shall be designed to achieve this objective.

Suspension or Disenrollment:

The director or other authorized authority may suspend or withdraw a child at anytime it is deemed their withdrawal is in the best interest of the other children, parents, staff and/or school.
